



Dress Code for Staff members of La Salle Malta Colleges and Schools

The attire of educators and all other staff members at La Salle Malta colleges should reflect not only the status and dignity of the teaching profession but also the respect towards human dignity which is at the heart of Christian values. All Lasallian partners are role models to the children in their care, each having an important part in instilling a positive example according to the role held. Hence, our appearance, style and dress should also serve as an example to our students.

Staff should consider the manner of dress and appearance appropriate to their professional role which may be different from that adopted in their personal life. Staff should ensure they are dressed decently, safely and appropriately for the tasks they undertake. This means that adults should wear clothing which:

- Promotes a positive and professional image;
- Is appropriate to their role;
- May not be viewed as offensive, revealing or provocative;
- Does not distract, cause embarrassment or give rise to misunderstanding;
- Is absent of offensive or contentious slogans.

The following dress code is therefore aimed at guiding staff members with regards to this aspect of school life.

1. All teaching and clerical staff are expected to wear clothes which are clean, neat and professionally appropriate, for example, collared shirts/polo shirts and neat trousers, jeans, skirts or dresses. Please note that jeans that are faded or torn, short skirts above the knee, transparent, tight-fitting, or revealing clothing and sleeveless tops or vests do not constitute such attire and should not be worn.
2. Hair should be kept clean and neat with the choice of hair style always remaining appropriate to a school environment.
3. Any attire having printing which may be deemed as being offensive, rude, discriminatory, or inappropriate should not be worn.
4. During the scholastic year when students and/or parents are attending school, all teachers and clerical staff should refrain from wearing any type of shorts or bermudas, except in the case of PE teachers during PE lessons or by staff members participating in sports activities during breaks.
5. Footwear should be smart, appropriate and safe for the activity being undertaken. No flip-flops or similar footwear are allowed.
6. Tattoos should not be visible. Tattoos should therefore be kept covered at all times.
7. Earrings/piercings should be worn very discreetly and should not be excessive. They should not be worn during activities where they may constitute a safety risk.

Kodiċi tal-Ilbies għall-membri tal-Istaff tal-Kulleġġi u l-Iskejjel ta' La Salle Malta

L-ilbies tal-edukaturi u l-membri l-oħra kollha tal-istaff fil-kulleġġi ta' La Salle Malta għandhom jirriflettu mhux biss l-istatus u d-dinjità tal-professjoni tal-għalliema iżda wkoll ir-rispett lejn id-dinjità umana li hija fil-qalba tal-valuri Nsara. L-imsieħba kollha Lasallijani huma mudelli għat-tfal fil-kura tagħhom, kull wieħed għandu parti importanti biex idaħħal eżempju pożittiv skont ir-rwol li jkollu. Għalhekk, id-dehra, l-istil u l-ilbies tagħna għandhom iservu wkoll bħala eżempju għall-istudenti tagħna.

Membri tal-istaff għandhom jqisu il-mod ta' ilbies u dehra xierqa għar-rwol professjonali tagħhom li jista' jkun differenti minn dak adottat fil-ħajja personali tagħhom. Il-membri tal-istaff għandhom jiżguraw li jilbsu b'mod diċenti, sigur u xieraq għax-xogħol li jagħmlu. Dan ifisser li l-adulti għandhom jilbsu ħwejjeġ li:

- jippromwovu immaġni pożittiva u professjonali;
- Huma xierqa għar-rwol tagħhom;
- Ma jistgħux jitqiesu bħala offensivi, jiżvelaw jew provokattivi;
- Ma jtellfux, ma jikkawżawx imbarazzament jew jagħtu lok għal nuqqas ta' ftehim;
- Huma nieqsa minn slogans offensivi jew kontenzjużi.

Il-kodiċi tal-ilbies li ġej huwa għalhekk immirat biex jiggwida lill-membri tal-istaff fir-rigward ta' dan l-aspett tal-ħajja tal-iskola.

1. L-edukaturi u l-istaff klerikali huma mistennija li jilbsu ħwejjeġ nodfa, puliti u professjonalment xierqa, pereżempju, qomos bl-għonq/polo shirts u qliezet puliti, jeans, dbielet jew ilbiesi. Jekk jogħġbok innota li jeans li huma faded jew imqattgħin, dbielet qosra 'l fuq mill-irkoppa, ħwejjeġ trasparenti, stretti, jew li jiżvelaw u tops jew flokkijiet mingħajr kmiem ma jikkostitwixxux tali ilbies u m'għandhomx jintlibsu.
2. Ix-xagħar għandu jinżamm nadif u pulit bl-għażla tal-istil tax-xagħar dejjem tibqa' xierqa għall-ambjent tal-iskola.
3. Kull ilbies li jkollu stampar li jista' jitqies bħala offensiv, goff, diskriminatorju, jew mhux xieraq m'għandux jintlibes.
4. Matul is-sena skolastika meta l-istudenti u/jew il-ġenituri jkun qed jattendu l-iskola, L-edukaturi u l-istaff klerika kollha għandhom joqogħdu lura milli jilbsu kwalunkwe tip ta' xorts jew bermudas, ħlief fil-każ ta' għalliema tal-PE waqt il-lezzjonijiet tal-PE jew minn membri tal-persunal li jipparteċipaw f'attivitajiet sportivi fil-break.
5. Ix-xedd tas-saqajn għandu jkun pulit, xieraq u sigur għall-attività li qed titwettaq. Mhuma permessi l-ebda flip-flops jew xedd tas-saqajn simili.
6. It-tpiġġijiet m'għandhomx ikunu viżibbli. It-tpiġġijiet għandhom għalhekk jinżammu mgħottija l-ħin kollu.
7. L-imsielet/piercings għandhom jintlibsu b'mod diskret ħafna u m'għandhomx ikunu eċċessivi. M'għandhomx jintlibsu waqt attivitajiet fejn jistgħu jikkostitwixxu riskju għas-saħħa u s-sigurtà'.
