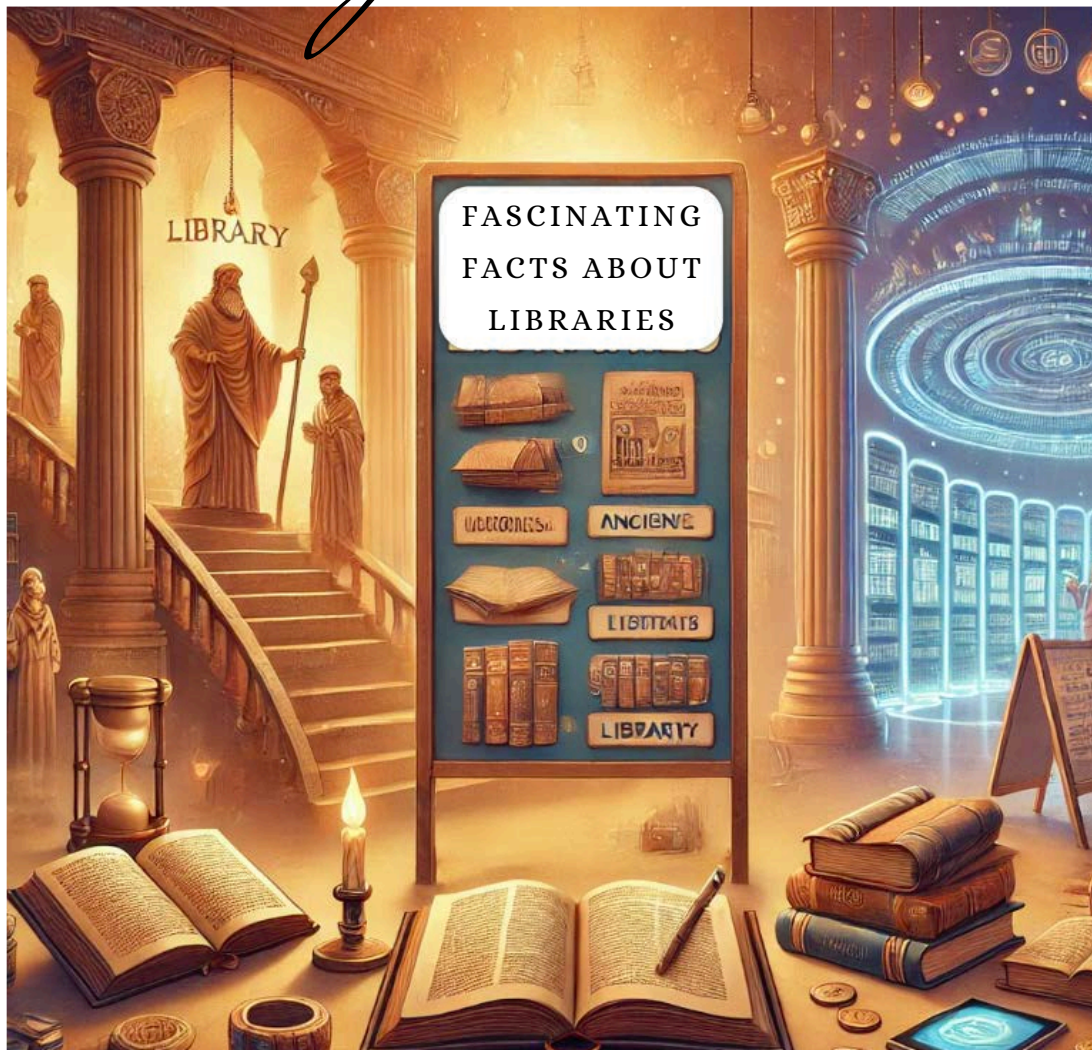
Bookmark Competition Winners

Did You Know?



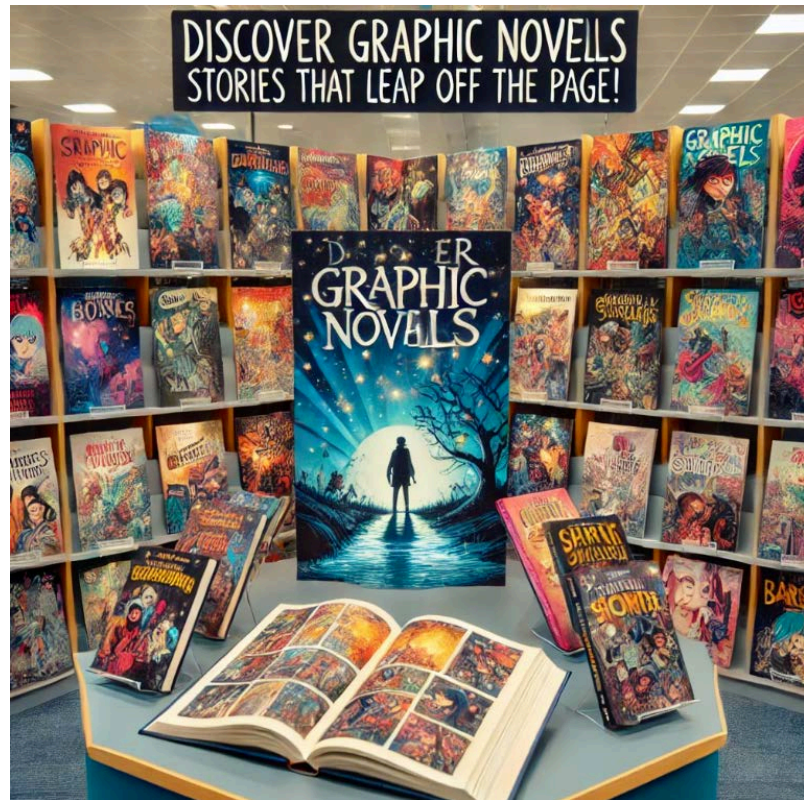
