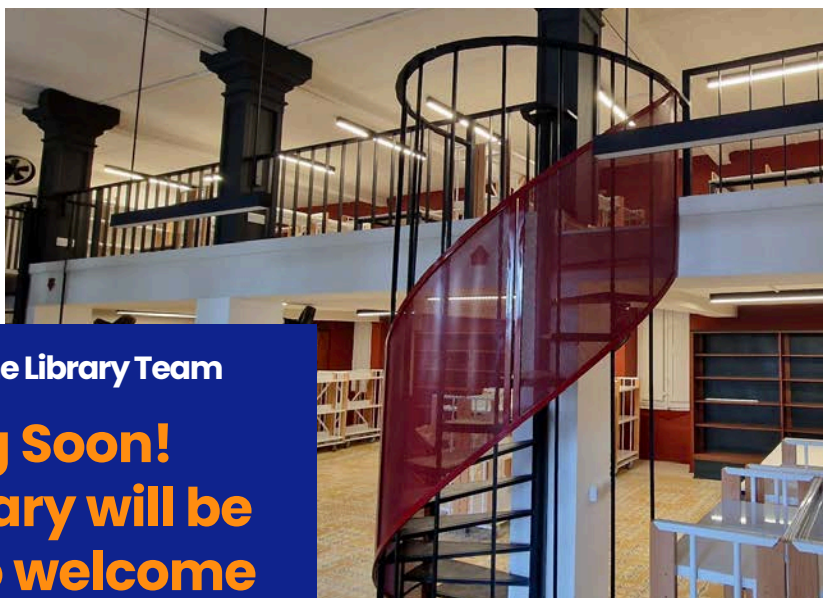

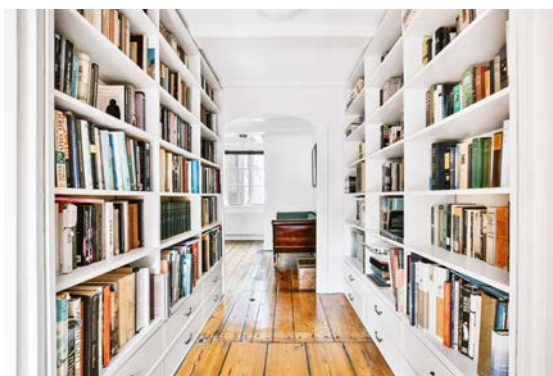

"A library is not just a collection of books, but a doorway to endless possibilities, where each page turns curiosity into knowledge and dreams into reality."

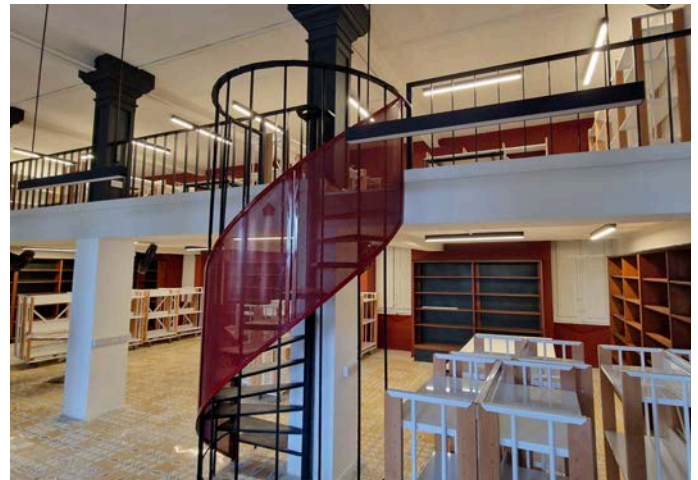

FOLLOW FOOD AND DRINK GUIDELINES:

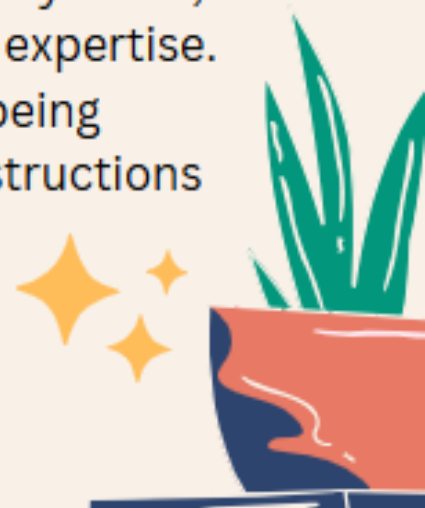

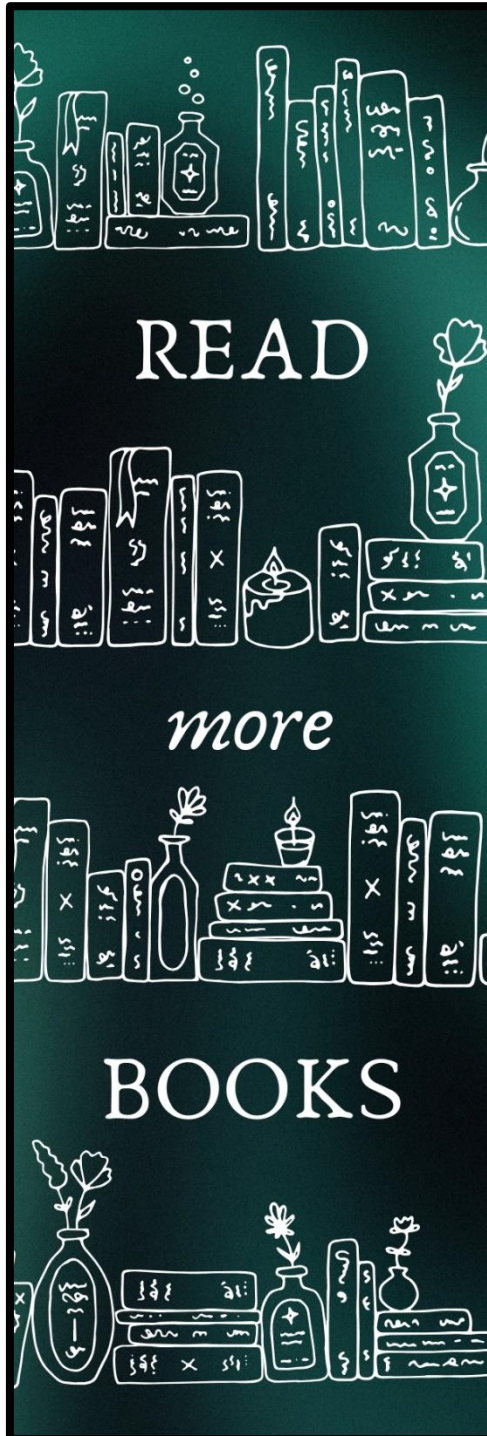
